

Full-time Teaching Position at the College of Nursing Art and Science, University of Hyogo:
Application Guidelines

The College of Nursing Art and Science, University of Hyogo is currently recruiting for a full-time teacher. Please refer to the following guidelines when applying.

1. Number of positions:

1: One Professor or Associate Professor ; Nursing Fondation (Nursing Informatics)

2. Courses to be responsible for:

Undergraduate	Nursing Informatics Community healthcare practice Integrated Nursing Practice practical research
Master's Course	Nursing Information Theory Nursing Information Standardization Theory Epidemiolog and Statistics Care Support System Seminar I Fundamentals of project research Practical Research on Nursing Informatics I • II

- (1) In addition to the above courses, the successful candidate will also be responsible for teaching various topic-based general education courses and World Nursing Issue on a rotational basis with other teachers.
- (2) The courses to be responsible for are subject to change after employment due to the university academic reorganization.
- (3) Some courses are taught by two teachers.

3. Eligibility requirements:

- (1) Doctoral degree (or equivalent education or research achievements)
- (2) Nursing license (to perform in a clinical setting in Japan under the Act on Public Health Nurses, Midwives, and Nurses)
- (3) Experience in clinical nursing, education, and research activities
- (4) None of the following items shall apply:
 - a. Persons sentenced to imprisonment or harsher penalties who have yet to complete their sentence or to whom such a sentence still applies.
 - b. Persons who have received punitive or disciplinary dismissal from Public University Corporation of the University of Hyogo or Hyogo Prefecture within two years of the date of such punishment.
 - c. Persons who, on or after the day of enforcement of the Constitution of Japan, have formed or become a member of a political party or any other organization which advocates the overthrow by force of the Constitution of Japan or the government existing under the Constitution.
- (5) Persons who are able to teach a class in Japanese.

4. The candidate will have:

- (1) Research achievements in a specialized field and a strong passion for education and research.
- (2) Ability to put front-line clinical experience to use in education and research.

(3) Enthusiasm about promoting research, such as industry-academia collaborations, for the benefit of society.

5. Application procedures:

(1) Documents to be submitted:

- a. Curriculum vitae (Form 1)
- b. Research achievements (Form 2) and reprint of major papers
- c. Educational history and activities in academic societies and society (Form 3)
- d. Outline of major research so far (Form 4) in about 800 words
- e. Aspirations for education and research (Form 5) in about 800 words
- f. Full copies of major academic papers
- g. Letter of recommendation (Free format) must be from department head or a person who can provide opinions on the field of specialty of the applicant. Also the letter must include the name and contact information of the person making the recommendation.

* As a general rule, application documents will not be returned.

(2) Submission method

Submit application materials in person or by mail. (*Please write “Teaching position application documents enclosed” in red ink on the envelope. If sending by mail, send by registered mail.)

January 12, 2024 (Friday) to March 12, 2024 (Tuesday) (application materials must arrive by this date)

7. Candidate selection:

Candidate selection will be based on an examination of application documents. Interviews and demo lessons will be held as necessary.

Applicants will be notified of the selection results by late June 2024.

8. Employment starts:

October 1, 2024 or April 1, 2025

9. Others:

We explicitly invite applicants qualified in research and education to apply.
